CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on May 20, 1976. On May 4, 1976, the Board issued an order establishing a bargaining unit consisting of the Custodians of the St. Albans City School Department including the Foremen.

1. On May 13, 1976 Alfred J. Schmitt, a member of the board, conducted an election by secret ballot of the custodians. Eight custodians were eligible to vote. The custodians were asked to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by the Custodians' Unit of the Vermont Education Association?


2. The result of the vote was: 5, yes; 3, no.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the Custodians' Unit of the St. Albans City Education Association is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for the bargaining unit consisting of the custodians of the St. Albans School District.
