CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on November 8, 1968.

1. On October 31, 1968, the parties filed with the State Labor Relations Board a stipulation for consent election of collective bargaining representatives for a bargaining unit of employees of the Barre Town School District designated as custodians, maintenance, grounds employees and bus drivers.

2. On November 4, 1968, an election was held under the supervision of William Lamsley and John Boylan, members of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. The employees of the bargaining unit were asked to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and its Local No. 1369.

The result of the vote was: Yes, 14; No, 2.

Now therefore it is hereby ORDERED that the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local No. 1369 is hereby certified as the collective bargaining representative of the custodians, maintenance, grounds employees and bus drivers of Barre Town School District. Said employees shall constitute a bargaining unit.
