This matter was brought before the Board by Petitioner Aides Unit of the St. Albans City Education Association through Norman P. Bartlett of the Vermont Education Association. On December 27, 1979 the Board received a letter from David M. Corey, Superintendent of Schools, St. Albans - Fairfield Supervisory Union, indicating that the St. Albans City Board of School Commissioners favored a consent election of the teachers aides. A consent election notice was sent to the Superintendent on January 31, 1979 scheduling the election for February 27, 1979 between 3:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. at the St. Albans City Elementary School. By consent of the parties, the election was postponed until March 7, 1979 at 3:30 p.m. at the St. Albans Elementary School and it took place at that time. Board Member Robert H. Brown conducted the election. Jane Clark observed the counting of the ballots for the Aides Association. No one observed for the School Commissioners. The results of the election were as follows:






