ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On April 26, 1979 the Stowe Staff Association, VEA/NEA Local 131 petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of collective bargaining representative for an employee unit in the Stowe School System. The question of eligibility of certain employees to be members of this bargaining unit was resolved between Alfred W. Hurley, Superintendent of Schools, Lamoyille South School District, and Richard D. Lang, Director, VEA/NEA UniServ District IV, and a consent election was scheduled

The consent election was conducted by Amy Kinzel for the Labor Relations Board on June 13, 1979 at the Stowe Elementary School and at the Stowe High School. Ms. Laurie Huse acted as observer for the union and Mr. Hurley observed for the administration. A total of 9 ballots were cast. The results of the election were as follows:




