
ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

This matter came before the Board as a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative by the Windham Southeast Staff Association on December 11, 1979. Pursuant to a stipulation dated February 20, 1980, entered into by Attorney Frederick Pope, representing the Board of Directors of Brattleboro Union High School No. 6, and Perry M. 
