ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On April 2, 1980 the Springfield School Staff Association, Local 630, VEA/NEA, petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for the secretarial, clerical, instructional, and noninstructional aide, maintenance, custodial, cafeteria, and transportation employees of the Springfield School Board. A stipulation listing confidential and supervisory positions to be excluded was filed on October 8, 1980. An amendment to the stipulation was filed on October 27, 1980.

A consent election was conducted on December 3, 1980 in Springfield by Board Member William G. Kemsley, Sr. The observers were Betty Dutton for the School Board and Perry Kacik for the Association. A total of 69 votes were cast and the tally was:





clerical, instructional and noninstructional aide, maintenance, custodial, cafeteria, and transportation employees of the Springfield School Board, excluding the employees in the positions listed in the stipulation and amendment.
