ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On June 25, 1980, the Windham Southeast Staff Association Local 719, VEA/NEA petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for the custodial, maintenance, secretarial, clerical, instructional and noninstructional aide and food service workers employed by the Brattleboro Town Board of School Directors. On July 2, 1980, Superintendent of Schools James J. Cusick filed notification of the school board's consent to the election.

The consent election was conducted by Labor Relations Board Member William G. Kemsley, Sr. on August 27, 1980, at the Oak Grove School in Brattleboro. Mr. Cusick acted as observer for the school board, and Perry Kacik of the Vermont Education Association observed for the association. A total of 32 votes were cast and the tally was:




As a result of this election, the Labor Relations Board hereby ORDERS the Windham Southeast Staff Association Local 719, VEA/NEA be CERTIFIED as





ORDER TO CLARIFY BARGAINING UNIT


Pursuant to the stipulation of the parties, the Labor Relations Board hereby orders that those employees who are secretary to a building principal be excluded from membership in the bargaining unit composed of custodial, maintenance, secretarial, clerical, institutional and non-institutional aide, and food service workers employed by the Brattleboro Town Board of School Directors, as these employees are confidential employees as defined in 21 V.S.A. §1722(6). This amends our order of certification in the above-entitled matter dated September 29, 1980.
