ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On July 14, 1980, the Washington Central Supervisory Union Staff Association, VEA/NEA Local 431, petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for the teacher aides employed by the Washington Central Supervisory Union Board of School Directors. On August 13, 1980, Superintendent Robert Arlin filed notification of the School Board's consent to the election.

The consent election was conducted by Martha J. Farmer, Clerk of the Labor Relations Board, on September 9, 1980, at the Berlin Elementary School Library. Allen Stook acted as observer for the association. No one appeared at the polls to serve as observer for the school board. A total of three votes were cast and the tally was:




