Order of Certification

On January 9, 1981, the St. Johnsbury Staff Association, through Allen T. Stook of the Vermont Education Association, petitioned the Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for the teacher aides employed by the St. Johnsbury Board of School Directors. On April 17, 1981, Edward R. Zuccaro, Esquire, representing the School District, notified the Labor Relations Board of the School Board's consent to an election.


Board Assistant Timothy J. Noonan conducted the election on May 19, 1981, at the Portland Street School. Present at the election as observers were Laurie B. Huse for the Association and Superintendent Joseph Kasprzak, followed by Frank Hebbard for the school district. A total of 16 ballots were cast and the tally was:

As a result of this election, the Vermont Labor Relations Board ORDERS the St. Johnsbury Staff Association, VEA/NEA Local 224, CERTIFIED as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for the teacher aides employed by the St. Johnsbury Board of School Directors.
