ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On November 18, 1987, the Orleans Central Staff Association, Vermont-NEA, NEA ("Association"), filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, requesting an election among the cooks, cafeteria workers, instructional and non-instructional teacher aides and custodians employed by the Brownington Board of School Directors ("Employer").

The Employer agreed to the conducting of a consent election among that unit of employees. The Labor Relations Board conducted an election on March 29, 1988, in the Conference room of the Brownington Elementary School, Brownington, Vermont. Dinah Yessne, Labor Relations Board Member, conducted the election. Raymond Gauthier, Business Manager for the Employer, observed for the Employer. The Association had no observer. Three of the four eligible employees voted.

The results of the election were:



As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED:


