ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On February 1, 1988, the Woodstock Union High School Teachers Organization Educational Support Personnel Unit, Vermont-NEA, NEA ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, requesting an election among the cafeteria workers, aides, custodians and secretaries employed by the Woodstock Union High School Board of School Directors ("Employer").

The Employer and Association resolved unit determination issues in dispute, and agreed that the employees in the following bargaining unit would vote in a consent election to determine whether they wished to be represented by the Association or no union: the cafeteria workers, aides, custodians and secretaries employed by the Employer; excluding the Principal's Secretary/Supervisor of Secretaries, the Lunchroom Supervisor and the Maintenance Supervisor.

The Labor Relations Board conducted an election on March 31, 1988, in the Library conference room, Woodstock Union High School, Woodstock, Vermont. Timothy Noonan, Board Executive Director, conducted the election. There were no observers present during balloting. All seventeen eligible employees voted.

The results of the election were:


As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED:


