ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On January 19, 1994, the Barnet Teachers ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative seeking an election among all custodians, kitchen staff, secretaries and paraprofessionals employed by the Barnet Board of School Directors ("Employer").


The Employer responded to the petition on February 9, 1994, and agreed to the conducting of an election among these employees. Linda McIntire, Labor Relations Specialist, conducted an election on March 8, 1994, in the kindergarten room of the Barnet School in Barnet, Vermont. Neither the Association nor the Employer had an observer during the conducting of the election. Martha Dunbar observed the counting of the ballots for the Association. Seventeen of the twenty-two eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Barnet Teachers Association. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED that the
Barnet Teachers Association is CERTIFIED as the exclusive
bargaining representative of all custodians, kitchen staff,
secretaries and paraprofessionals employed by the Barnet Board of
School Directors.
