ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On December 28, 1998, the Orleans Central Education Association/Vermont-NEA/NEA ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative to represent for exclusive bargaining purposes all paraeducators and custodians employed by the Irasburg Village Board of School Directors ("Employer").

On January 19, 1999, the Employer responded to the petition and agreed to the conducting of a consent election among these employees. On February 10, 1999, Vermont Labor Relations Board Election Officer Linda P. McIntire conducted an election in the library of the Irasburg School. Association President Gregory Tocci observed for the Association. Superintendent Richard Aubuchon observed for the Employer. Three of the seven eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Orleans Central Education Association/Vermont-NEA/NEA. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED that the Orleans Central Education Association/Vermont-NEA/NEA is CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative of all paraeducators and custodians employed by the Irasburg Village Board of School Directors.


