

The ballots were counted by the Board on August 8, 1989, at the Board hearing room, 13 Baldwin Street, Montpelier, Vermont. Timothy Noonan, Board Executive Director, counted the ballots, Present as observers during the counting of the ballots were Thomas Ball, State Employee Relations Director, and Steve Janson, VSEA Field Services Director. Twenty-nine of 42 eligible employees voted. The results on the question were:

No ballots were challenged. Subsequent to the counting of the ballots, the Board received three additional mail ballots from employees. These ballots were not counted and remain sealed.


As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED:


