The Board welcomed Michelle Phelps who has been appointed by Governor Scott as our new Board Member.

## Review Annual Report

The Board discussed the annual report at length and recommended several edits. Chair Park directed Board Members to email any additional changes to Executive Director Dillon, copying other Board Members, by the end of the week.

## Discuss Transition between Mr. Park and Ms. Phelps

Ms. Phelps will sit in, as a non-participating Board Member, at a hearing on January 26<sup>th</sup> to observe a hearing before she serves on a panel. On February 1, she will begin her training on the jurisdiction of the Board, hearings, and practice and procedure participates with Ms. Dillon.

Chair Park will Chair the panel scheduled for January 26, which will continue on February 23. February 23, will be the last day he will serve on a hearing panel. He will continue to deliberate or review decisions on matters he Chaired before retiring from the Board. The Board reviewed and revised the hearing panel assignments.
