ORDER

WHEREAS, on January 31, 1985, the Vermont Labor Relations Board certified the Barre City Police Officers Association as the exclusive bargaining representative of patrol officers, sergeants, corporal/investigating officers, clerk/dispatchers, and parking meter technician/maintenance person, excluding the Chief of Police and Deputy Chief of Police, employed by the Barre City Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Local 1369, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO ("AFSCME") has requested the Board to amend its order of certification of January 31, 1985, to indicate the Barre City Police Officers Association is affiliated with AFSCME; and

WHEREAS, AFSCME has demonstrated the members of the Barre City Police Officers Association have elected to affiliate with AFSCME; and

WHEREAS, the City of Barre and the Barre City Police Officers Association have expressed no objection to such amendment of certification; and


WHEREAS, no rival employee organization is seeking to represent the same group of employees; and

WHEREAS, no question of representation exists pursuant to 21 VSA §1724 requiring a hearing or election, it is hereby ORDERED:


The January 31, 1985, Certification Order of the Board is AMENDED to provide the Barre City Police Officers Association, affiliated with Local 1369, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, is CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative of patrol officers, sergeants, corporal/investigating officers, clerk/dispatchers, and parking meter technician/maintenance persons, excluding the Chief of Police and Deputy Chief of Police, employed by the Barre City Police Department.
