ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On June 26, 1997, the Chauffeurs, Teamsters Union Local 597 ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative to represent all full time dispatchers and police officers, excluding the Police Chief, employed by the Town of Williston ("Employer").

On July 22, 1997, the Employer responded to the petition and raised a question of unit determination, contending that the position of sergeant is a supervisory position and, thus, should be excluded from the proposed bargaining unit. On September 16, 1997, the Employer withdrew this objection and agreed to the conducting of a consent election among these employees.

On October 1, 1997, Vermont Labor Relations Board Election Agent Linda McIntire conducted an election in the conference room of the Williston municipal offices, 722 Williston Road, Williston, Vermont. Assistant Town Clerk Kathy Boyden observed for the Employer. Duane Messier, Business Agent for the Union, observed for the Union. All five eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Chauffeurs,

Teamsters Union Local 597. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED that the Chauffeurs, Teamsters Union Local 597 is CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative of all full time dispatchers and police officers, excluding the Police Chief, employed by the Town of Williston.


