ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On February 10, 1997, Local 3797, AFSCME Council 93 ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative to represent for exclusive bargaining purposes all police officers, excluding the Chief of Police, employed by the Town of Norwich ("Employer").
