DECERTIFICATION ORDER

On December 23, 1981, Local 1201, AFSCME, ("Union") filed a petition with the Vermont Labor Relations Board, requesting the Board decertify the Union as the collective bargaining representative of the Clerks and Technical Employees Unit since a majority of the Unit no longer desired to be represented by the Union. At a hearing held on a related case involving the Union and the City of Rutland (Docket No. 81-44) held December 23, 1981, before the Board, the Board stated it would decertify the clerical unit if the parties personally notified all City employees affected by such decertification by January 8, 1982, that the Board would decertify the clerical unit unless there was objection to such decertification sent to the Board postmarked no later than January 15, 1982.

The affected employees having been so notified, and the Board receiving no objection to decertifying the clerical unit, it is hereby ORDERED:

Local 1201, AFSCME, is DECERTIFIED as the collective bargaining representative for the employees in the Clerks and Technical Employees Unit of the City of Rutland.
