ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On February 24, 2004, AFSCME Council 93, Local 1369 ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, seeking to represent the copy/supply clerk, administrative assistant, registrar, receptionist, special services / business administrative assistant and administrative assistant/secretary employed by the Barre Town School District ("Employer"), and adding them to the existing bargaining unit of custodians, grounds employees, maintenance employees and bus drivers represented by the Union.

In response to the petition, the Employer contended that the special services / business administrative assistant, administrative assistant and administrative assistant / secretary should be excluded from the proposed addition to the bargaining unit as confidential employees. The parties resolved the unit determination issues by agreeing to: 1) exclude the special services/business administrative assistant from the proposed bargaining unit as a confidential employee, and 2) include the administrative assistant and administrative assistant/secretary in the proposed unit.

On June 14, 2004, Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan conducted an election among the copy/supply clerk, administrative assistant, registrar, receptionist and administrative assistant/secretary in the upstairs conference room of the Barre Town Elementary School. Thomas Whitney, Union International Representative,

was present as an observer for the Union. The Employer had no observer. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by AFSCME Council 93, Local 1369. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is ordered that AFSCME Council 93, Local 1369 is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the copy/supply clerk, administrative assistant, registrar, receptionist and administrative assistant/secretary employed by the Barre Town School District, and such employees are added to the existing bargaining unit of custodians, grounds employees, maintenance employees and bus drivers represented by the Union.
