ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On August 24, 1979, the Vermont Education Association petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for an employee unit in the Windsor Town School District. The Windsor School Board filed an answer to the petition on September 27, 1979. A hearing was held on the matter on November 8, 1979 in Montpelier, Vermont. All members of the Board were present. The Vermont Education Association was represented by Steven R. Adams, Director of VEA/NEA UniServ District V. The Windsor School Board was represented by Attorney Trine Bech.

On December 13, 1979, the Labor Relations Board ordered that a collective bargaining unit for secretaries, custodians and food service employees employed by the Windsor Town School District is appropriate, with the exception of the positions of Maintenance Supervisor and Food Service Manager; and that a secret election be held.


The election was conducted by Board Member William G. Kemsley, Sr. on January 29, 1980 at the Windsor High School Library. Ms. Ramona Lasure acted as observer for VEA. There was no representative for the School Board. A total of eleven votes were cast. The tally was as follows:


Windsor School Staff Association, VEA/NEA:	10

As a result of this election, it is ORDERED that Windsor School Staff Association be CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative for the secretaries, custodians and food service employees employed by the Windsor Town School District, with the exception of the Maintenance Supervisor and Food Service Manager.
