ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On February 14, 1991, the Woodstock Elementary Educators Association/Vermont-NEA/NEA ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, requesting an election among all non-certified, non-supervisory employees, including the Head Custodian and Cafeteria Supervisor, but excluding the Administrative Secretary, employed by the Woodstock Elementary Board of School Directors ("Employer").

The Employer initially raised questions of unit representation, but ultimately agreed to the conducting of a consent election among this group of employees. Linda McIntire, Labor Relations Board Legal Assistant, conducted an election on April 29, 1991, in the Art Room of the Woodstock Elementary School in Woodstock, Vermont. Ellen David Friedman, Vermont-NEA Organizer, was present as an observer for the Association. No Employer observer was present. All 15 eligible employees voted.
