## **UNIT CLARIFICATION ORDER**

On August 5, 1991, the Vermont Labor Relations Board certified the Village of Essex Junction Employees' Association ("Association") as the exclusive bargaining representative of the employees employed by the Village of Essex Junction, excluding supervisory and confidential employees. On July 19, 2023, the City of Essex Junction, formerly the Village of Essex Junction, and the Association filed a stipulation to clarify the new eligible employees in the unit. Pursuant to the stipulation, the following positions are eligible:

Assistant Clerk, Town Planner, Assistant Technical Services and Program Librarian

The parties stipulate that the following new positions are not eligible in the unit:

Accountant II, Administrative Assistant.

The Board adopts the above unit clarification and orders that the following positions be added to the unit:

Assistant Clerk, Town Planner, Assistant Technical Services and Program Librarian
