ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On July 10, 2020, the International Union of Public Employees (“Union”) filed an amended Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, seeking to represent all full-time and regularly scheduled part-time assistants, bookkeepers, highway and water/sewer public works employees of the Town of Woodstock (“Employer”). The Employer filed a response to the petition on July 30, 2020, agreeing to the conducting of a representation election among these employees.

The Labor Relations Board conducted a secret ballot election by mail. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the International Union of Public Employees. Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan counted the ballots on October 14, 2020, in the Labor Relations Board hearing room, 13 Baldwin Street, Montpelier. Mary Riley, Selectboard Chair for the Employer, observed the counting of ballots for the Employer via video. Union Representative Chris Hoar observed the count for the Union via video. Ten of the twelve eligible employees voted. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is ordered that the International Union of Public Employees is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of all full-time and regularly scheduled part-time assistants, bookkeepers, highway and water/sewer public works employees of the Town of Woodstock
