## **ORDER OF CERTIFICATION**

On November 2, 2020, Local 2413, AFSCME Council 93, AFL-CIO ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative seeking to add the Parks and Recreation Supervisor and the Parks and Recreation Foreman of the City of Newport Parks and Recreation Department to the Department of Public Works bargaining unit represented by the Union. The City of Newport ("Employer") filed a response to the petition on November 20, 2020, agreeing to the conducting of a representation election among these employees.

The Labor Relations Board conducted a secret ballot election by mail. The Parks and Recreation Supervisor and the Parks and Recreation Foreman of the City of Newport Parks and Recreation Department were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by Local 2413, AFSCME Council 93, AFL-CIO. Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan counted the ballots on December 31, 2020, in the Labor Relations Board hearing room, 13 Baldwin Street, Montpelier. Attorney John Klesch observed the counting of ballots for the Employer via video. The Union had no observer. One of the two eligible employees voted. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is ordered that Local 2413, AFSCME Council 93, AFL-CIO, is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the Parks and Recreation Supervisor and the Parks and Recreation Foreman of the City of Newport Parks and Recreation Department, and such employees are added to the existing Department of Public Works bargaining unit represented by Local 2413, AFSCME Council 93, AFL-CIO.
